## Please follow these instructions and NOT the instructions on the package/box

## For all procedure times in the Morning:

- 1. Mix laxative drink (prescription) in the morning. Add a flavor pack (if it comes with your prescription) or crystal light lemonade flavor only.
- 2. Fill the container to the water line, shake, and refrigerate (may be room temperature if preferred)
- 3. Starting at 5pm the day before your procedure
  - a. Drink an 8oz glass every 15 minutes until the bottle is ½ gone. Refrigerate the remaining prep.
- 4. Starting at **11pm** 
  - a. Drink an 8oz glass every 15 minutes until gone. Follow with 16oz of clear liquid of your choice within 1 hour
- 5. You can drink other clear liquids with the prep and clear liquids throughout the day before your procedure.
- 6. STOP DRINKING 4 hours prior to your arrival time for your procedure.

## For all procedure arrival times after 11:30am:

- 1. Mix laxative drink (prescription) in the morning. Add a flavor pack (if it comes with your prescription) or crystal light lemonade flavor only.
- 2. Fill the container oto the water line, shake, and refrigerate (may be room temperature if preferred)
- 3. Starting at **5pm the day before your procedure** 
  - a. Drink an 8oz glass every 15 minutes until the bottle is ½ gone. Refrigerate the remaining prep.
- 4. Starting at 6am the day of your procedure
  - a. Drink an 8oz glass every 15 minutes until gone. Follow with 16oz of clear liquid of your choice within 1 hour
- 5. You can drink other clear liquids with the prep and clear liquids throughout the day before your procedure.
- 6. STOP DRINKING 4 hours prior to your arrival time for your procedure.

If you take blood pressure, heart, seizure or anxiety meds in the morning, please take them **at least 2 hours** prior to your arrival. Please take them with only a sip of water. All other meds can be held until after the procedure.

**Please be advised** - 2-5 days prior to your procedure you will get a MyChart message titled "Procedure Reminder. Read the entire Message". This message will tell you your arrival time. If you do not have MyChart access you will be called.
